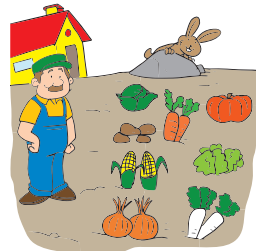

The next day the farmer built a hut for the rabbit. Now the rabbit is farmer's pet and lives on the farm.

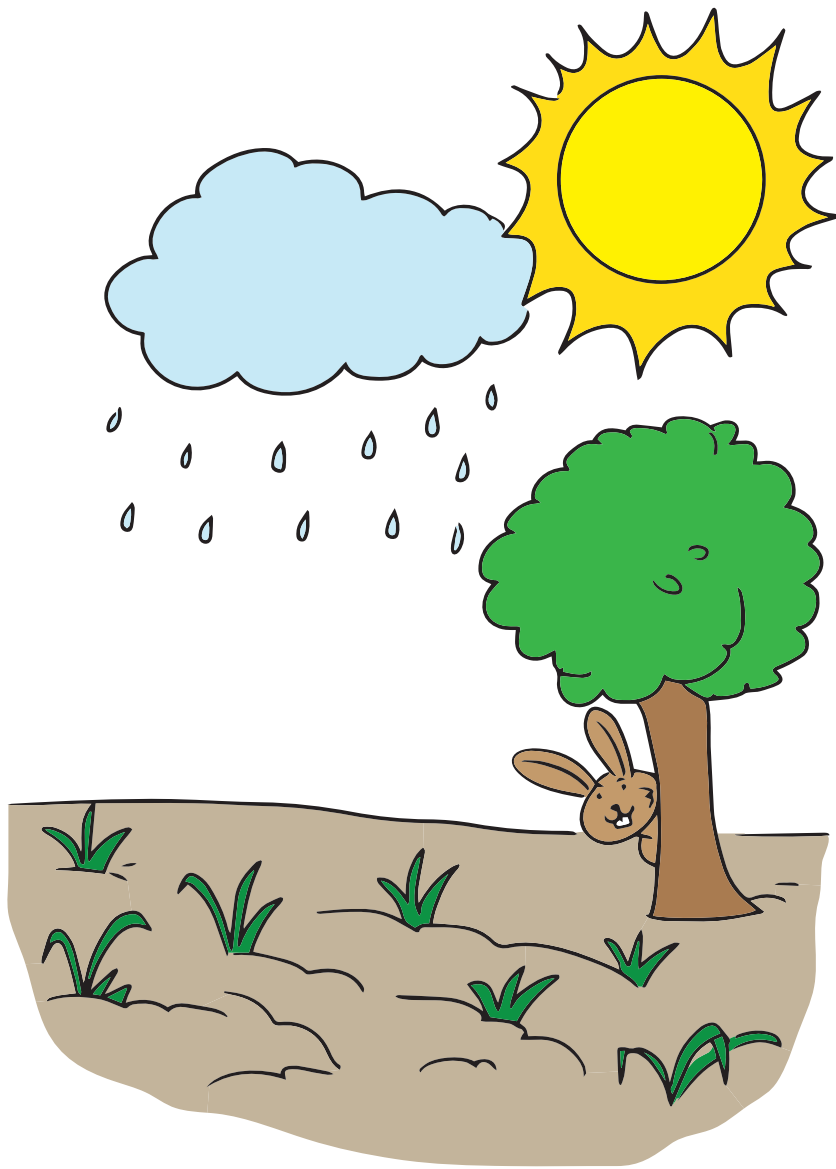
Every day the farmer gives the rabbit lots of carrots to eat.

Just as the rabbit reached the cabbage, the farmer quickly swung his net and caught the rabbit!

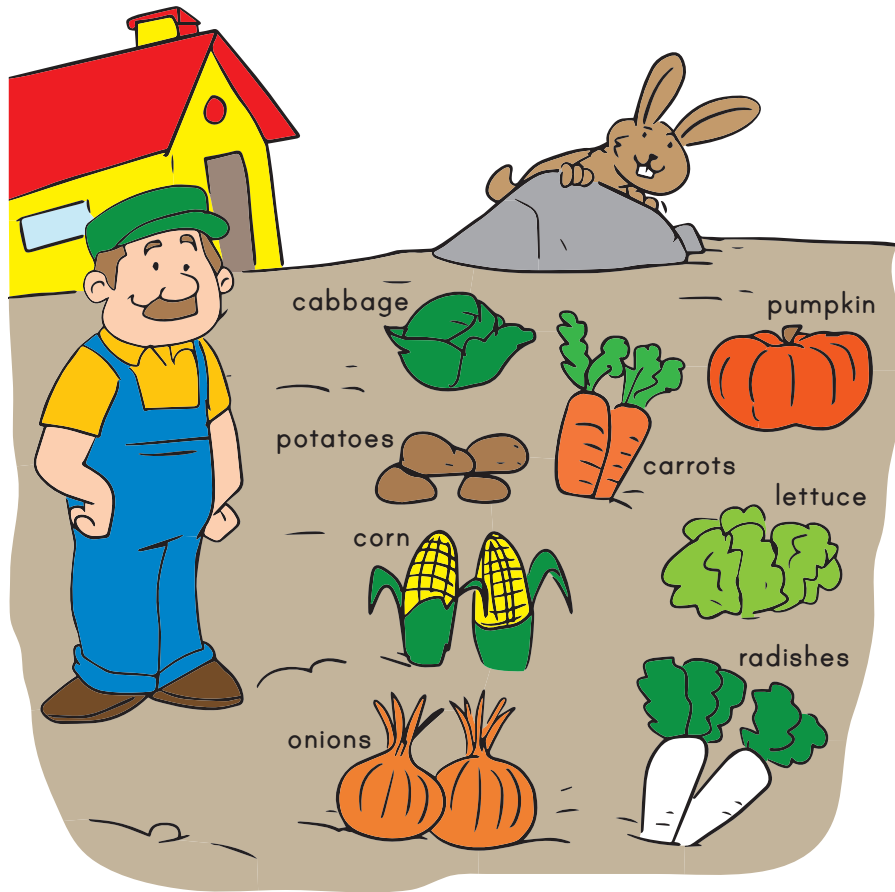
“Now I know why my vegetables keep disappearing!”, said the farmer excitedly.
